

Update – 10 April 2020 Extension of curfew to prevent the spread of Covid-19

Dear Valued Partners

In our communique of 31 March 2020, we had informed you that the curfew had been extended in Mauritius until 15 April 2020. Following a Cabinet meeting yesterday 10 April 2020, the Honourable Prime Minister announced that the curfew will be further extended until Monday 4 May 2020. Although the number of confirmed cases so far was below WHO projections, the Government took the view that a further period of vigilance was required.

Our Business Continuity Plan remains operational and our employees are continuously working from home in order to service client needs.

With respect to Court matters, a limited service is available via technological means for urgent matters. Milestones for all cases which are recorded on the electronic filing system of the Commercial Division of the Surpreme Court have been waived until further notice. Other public services are also putting in place online services to assist the public and minimise disruption.
